**CQR** (Certified, Qualified, and Ready to Go) courses are designed to help members complete training in specific mission areas. The training event goal is for each participant to leave D-Train Certified, Qualified, and Ready to perform their missions as studied.

The training features a wide range of **C,Q,R** courses designed to qualify members in missions such as food service and sanitation, telecommunications, recruiting, emergency management, on water and in air operations as well as core Auxiliary missions such as Public Affairs mascot training and certification, AUXDATA II training, pollution responder training, and potentially more.

Sign up promptly, as course spots are limited, and all hands are required to attend the Saturday evening ALL HANDS session. Division Commanders (DCDRs), let your Flotilla Commanders (FCs) know of this upcoming training and to get it to the deck plate membership *immediately* so they have time to plan their opportunity to train and fellowship.
